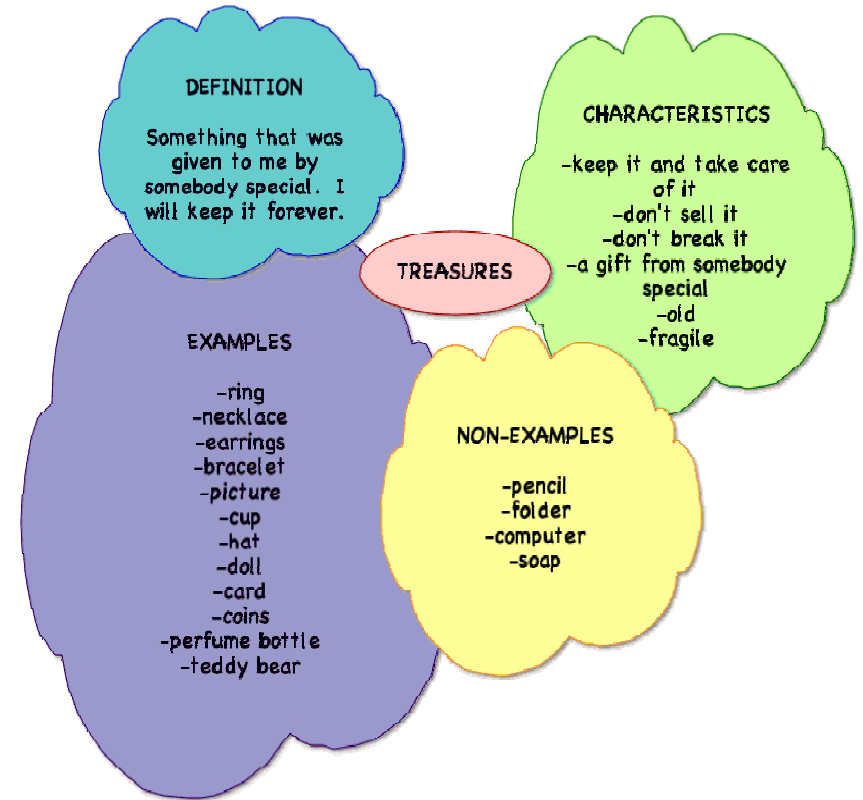

The tie belonged to my grandpa. Grandpa gave it to my dad, who gave it to me.

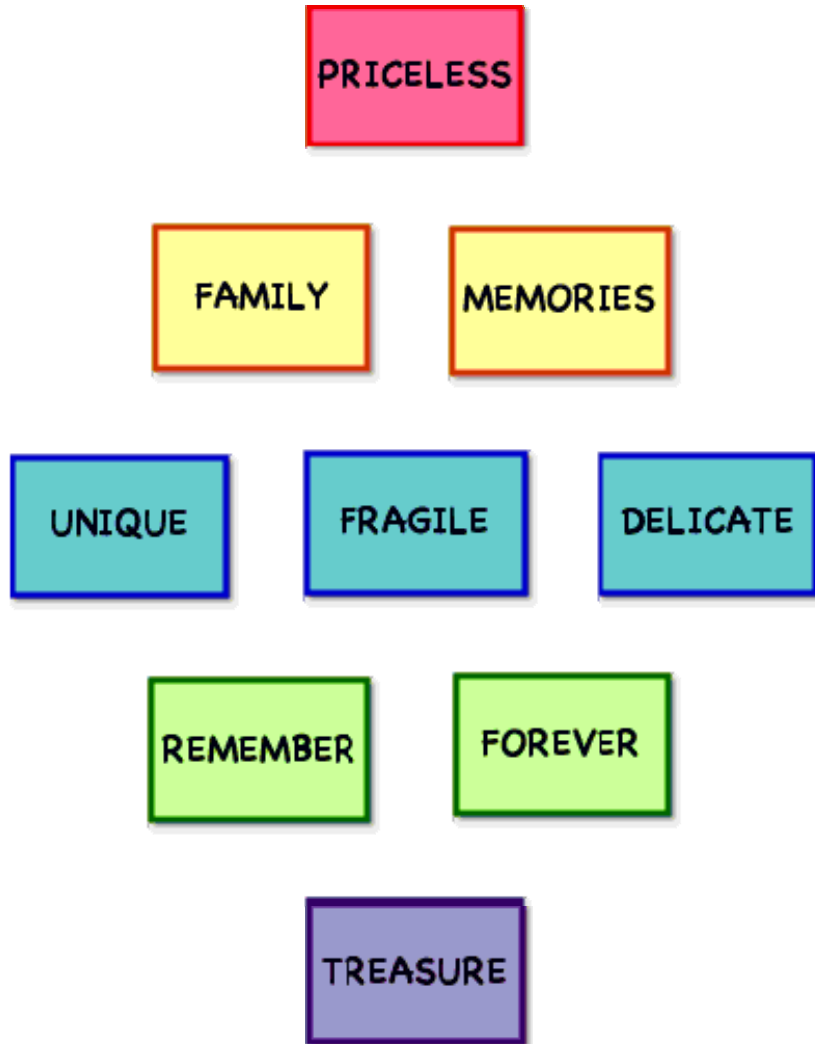


FRAYER MODEL

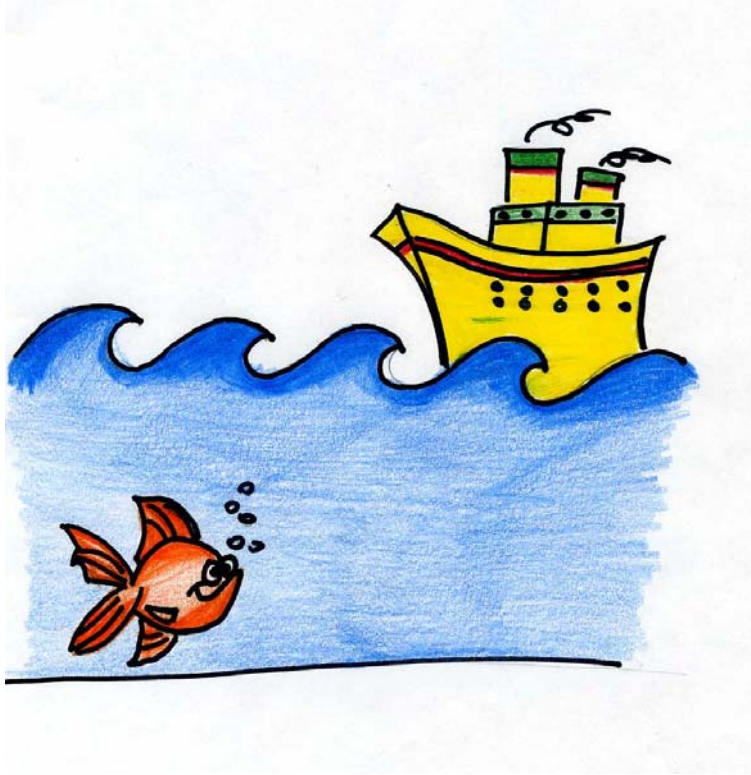


My dad wore it when he graduated from university.
